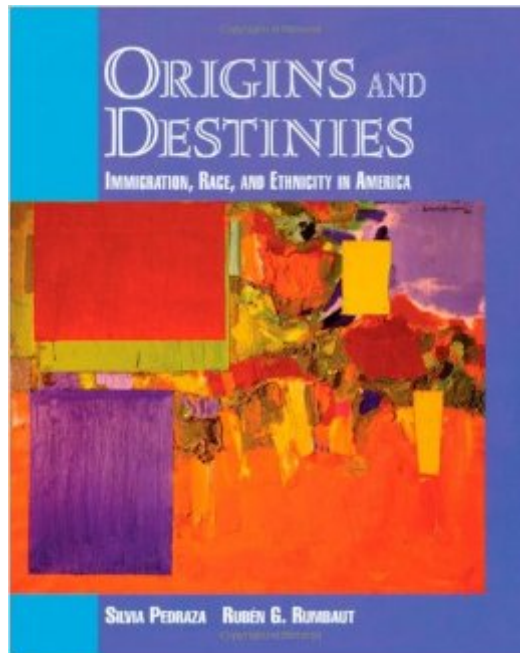


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# Origins And Destinies: Immigration, Race, And Ethnicity In America
