

This highly readable book is useful both for the general reader who wants to know what globalization is about and for the professor who wants a book that students will understand and enjoy. I teach a course on globalization and searched long and hard for the right book to accompany the course. I have been totally satisfied with this one. The articles are clear, informative, and balanced. There is a variety of viewpoints, ranging from the pro-globalization Thomas Friedman to critics, such as Jeremy Brecher. The breadth of topics is excellent. A few examples include agricultural issues, environment, immigration, cybercrime, terrorism, slavery, gender, racism, and global movements.

This book was purchased as a textbook on a class on Globalization. Though I haven't finished the book yet I must say so far it hasn't been as bad as other textbooks I've had on similar subject matters. Its broken down into chapters and each chapter has a few articles on different aspects of globalization.
